We love growing tulips for their elegant blooms and long, sturdy stems. Plus, they're the epitome of spring! Tulips are the perfect cut flower for a beginner or experienced gardener.

Here are some tips for planting your tulip bulbs:

- Plant bulbs in the fall in October or November before the ground freezes to have springtime blooms.
- Bulbs need a lot of room: plant 6"-8" deep and spaced 4"-6" apart.
- Plant them somewhere with full sun or partial shade.
- Typical hardiness zones for tulips are Zones 3-8 (Champaign-Urbana is in Zone 6a)

• Deer and rodents also love tuips, so keep an eye out for thieves! We sprinkle organic granular vole scram to help deter them.
